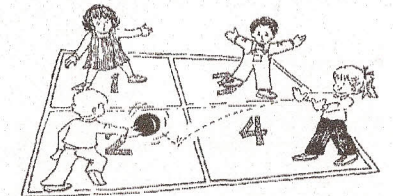

4-5 Year Old Program

Sometimes hanging with the Big Kids can be a little overwhelming for younger participant, so this year we decided to give our younger campers a home of their own. They will meet at **Stony Brook School** as a home base on Mon-Wed. On Thursdays and Fridays campers should come to Vermeule for Trips and Workshops. Our onsite ratio for this group will be 1 to 10 with a Site Coordinator and Group Leader. The off site ratio will be smaller. Parent participation on field trips is strongly encouraged. We offer an early drop off (7:30 am) and late pick up (4:00 pm) at this location for an additional fee. 4 year olds must be 5 by October 15, 2011 to attend. Proof of birth required. All children must be toilet trained.

6-7 and 8-9 Year Old Program

This year we split our **Vermeule** Location into two programs, the 6-7 Lower Elementary and 8-9 Upper Elementary Program. Each will have their own Group Leader and age appropriate activities and outings to fit their development level. The ration is 1 to 12 .We are offering an early drop off (7:30am) and a late pick up (4:00pm) at this location for an additional fee. A camper's age by October 15, 2011 determines the cut off for each age group.
